Adopting a kitten, cat, puppy, or dog is a serious responsibility. The cat/dog you adopt today
will likely be a part of your family for the next 15 to 20 years. Each cat/dog had its own distinct
personality and preferences, some of which you can help shape, others which you cannot
change. A pet makes considerable demands on your time and resources. Cat/dog owners need
to spend time cleaning litter boxes, socializing, grooming, feeding and playing with their cat/

dog each day. Cats/dogs that are shy or have not had much human contact need even more time and socialization. All cats/dogs require special food and regular veterinary care; these expenses could exceed \$500 a year, not including unforeseen veterinary expenses. Start-up costs could be another \$75 -\$175.
